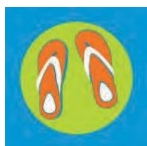

Seaton Wetlands Nature Reserve - Nearly 4km of level trails and boardwalk through beautiful marshland and reed beds alongside the river Axe, home to an abundance of wildlife. Seaton Wetlands is made up of four main sites - Seaton Marshes, Black Hole Marsh, Colyford Common and Stafford Marsh. There is also a new 'Lookout'. The signposted trails at the Wetlands make them ideal for a peaceful stroll in the fresh air; you can also have fun pond dipping, or enjoying a picnic with family and friends as well as getting to see your wonderful local wildlife up close from the five hides. eastdevon.gov.uk/countryside/countryside-sites/seaton-wetlands

Grades Explained



Grade 1

Approx. 20 - 30 Mins

For those just starting to exercise who would find hills a problem, on mostly flat level footpaths.



Grade 2

Approx. 30 - 60 Mins

For those who can do a little exercise and cope with gentle on mostly flat and level footpaths but with some slight gradients.



Grade 3

Approx. 60 - 90 Mins

For those able to walk at moderate speed, with slopes and uneven pathways. On footpaths and pavements with some gradients and hills. Steps with handrails and stiles in some places. It can be slippery under foot when wet.
